

What Does Parish Leadership Require?

Vestry leadership in the parish means praying, supporting, and participating fully in the life of the parish. There is a monthly meeting (2nd Monday), and members are asked to give of their time and talent in our ministries as they are called. A Warden works closely with the Rector to assist in leading the Vestry, acting as lay counsel to his pastoral leadership.

Diocesan/Convocation delegates attend the annual Diocesan Convention (March 7th this year) and the twice a year Convocation meeting in the spring and the fall.

The chair of the Stone Scholarship Committee assembles a small group of parishioners in order to award scholarships to St. Peter's members who are pursuing higher education or vocational training.

If there is someone you think is called to these roles, speak to them to secure their permission to submit their name using the nomination forms in the church. Nominations will be open for the next few weeks leading up to the Vestry Day of Discernment on January 10th.
